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POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR
CROWN & BRIDGE PREPARATION ON ROOT CANAL TOOTH

1. You may chew right away on the temporary, however, Do Not chew sticky foods –especially gum, carame , etc., these foods will stick or possibly pull the temporary crown off.
2. If temporary crown or bridge comes o or becomes loose, save the temporary and call the office IMMEDIATELY s we can recement it. If it is not recemented right away, you will risk the tooth, and the permanent crown may not fit.
3. The gum tissue may be sore for 2-3 days. You may rinse with warm salt water rinses or Peroxyl to help the healing process. When flossing, pull the floss through. You may use floss threaders or super floss.
4. Jf you are going away for any length of time while the temporary crown or bridge is in; let us know so we can use a more permanent cement.
5. Ifwe are away, we always have two or three dentists covering. Ifthe temporary comes off, make sure one of these offices recements the temporary right away.
6. You may experience some blisters in the gum tissue on or around the tooth/teeth that was prepared today. These are a fairly common occurrence. They should disappear in a few days. Ifthey seem to be extreme, please call the office.
